



## 2018 Ride FAQ's



### 2018 ND2UD Ride: Saturday, July 28-Tuesday, July 31

Can I register online?

**Yes! On the scrolling images on the home page, click on the ND2UD image. It will take you to the page that explains your registration options.**

Where is the ride starting from?

**This year the ride will start at the University of Notre Dame (July 28) and end at the University of Dayton (July 31).**

How do the bikes and people get to ND?

**There are two departure times available on the Friday before the ride, at 9:30 am and 1:00 pm. The riders will carpool to ND and their bikes will be transported with them. There are accommodations for the riders to spend Friday night at ND.**

If I am traveling from out of town to be part of the bike ride, should I join the group in Dayton or at Notre Dame?

**Riders should join the group in Dayton prior to the bike ride so they will have their cars at the end of the ride. Free, secure parking is provided near Old River Park/UD.**

What are the ride distances each day?

**ND to Winona Lake = 55 miles**

**Winona Lake to Decatur = 65 miles**

**Decatur to New Bremen = 56 miles**

**New Bremen to UD = 64 miles**

What are the stops each day? Where do the riders eat and sleep on their way back to UD?

**The first day ends at Winona Lake, IN. Lodging, dinner and breakfast will be provided.**

**The second day ends in Decatur, IN. Lodging, dinner and breakfast will be provided**

**The third day ends at New Bremen/Minster, Ohio. Lodging, dinner and breakfast will be provided.**

**The riders will arrive at University of Dayton around 1:00pm on Tuesday, July 31.**

**The accommodations are high school gyms, college gyms, and a Knights of Columbus Hall. We provide air mattresses. The riders will need to bring sleeping bag/blankets. They will have bathrooms and showers. Breakfast will be provided each morning as well as dinner. Everyone is on their own for lunch.**

What are some other amenities of this trip?

**SAG drivers accompany the riders throughout the trip to provide water, first aid, snacks, repair items (bike mechanic rides with the group). Rest stops are every 15-20 miles.**

When we return to Dayton on Tuesday, will there be food available at Old River Park?

**Yes, there will be sandwiches from WG Grinders, and Dilly Bars from Dairy Queen. There will also be a silent auction with fun items available to bid on!**

Is there a meeting prior to the ride that will cover this information?

**Yes, there will be a meeting on Thursday, July 26 at 5:00 pm at the DRTL office. Riders will receive their t-shirts (and jerseys if they purchased one). Riders will also receive a suggested packing list as we get closer to the ride.**

What DRTL activities is my registration fee supporting? I see that my payment for this event goes to Dayton Right to Life Society--what does that mean?
