Despite the initial concerns regarding Melissa's future after surviving the attempt to end her life at approximately seven months gestation, she has not only survived but thrived. With a Master's Degree in Social Work, she has worked in the fields of substance abuse, mental health, domestic violence and sexual assault counseling, and child welfare. Her life is a testament to the beauty of God's grace in our lives, the power of love, the transformational power of forgiveness, and answering God's call for your life.

"I've lived out the unplanned, the unexpected in my life in many ways, and I understand how frightening the unknown in our lives can be. I want to encourage you, though, to take that first step out into the unplanned, the unexpected, and experience the amazing blessings that come from living out the story of your life, even when you can't see the story in its' entirety to know how it will end."

Fulfilling the purpose that she believes God set out for her when He saved her from the certain death of the abortion attempt, Melissa is truly a voice for the voiceless.

As a rising voice on the music stage, Caitlin Jane has a unique presence—offering not only amazing gifts of poetic songwriting and performance, but delivering with these a passionate message of hope in a broken world.

In recent years, Caitlin Jane has walked an unexpected journey and has received a second chance at life. In June 2014, she was diagnosed with a brain tumor that was considered inoperable. In February 2015, she underwent life-saving endoscopic brain surgery. The tumor posed serious risks to her critical nerves and brain stem, but by God's healing grace she is able today to walk, talk, sing, hear, and see.

Just two months after surgery, Caitlin's soon-to-be fiancé, and now husband, Jamie, was diagnosed with cancer. All they could do was trust the Lord with complete abandon and faith. Jamie finished his chemo treatment just five days before their September 2015 wedding, and the couple remains truly in awe of the many miracles God has granted along their journey. The newlywed couple was told that due to chemo treatments, the chances of having biological children would be nearly impossible, but God decided to bless them with a baby boy, which astounded the doctors!

"We've learned to live on purpose, to take no day for granted, and to immerse ourselves in daily prayer—lessons I don't ever want to forget."
