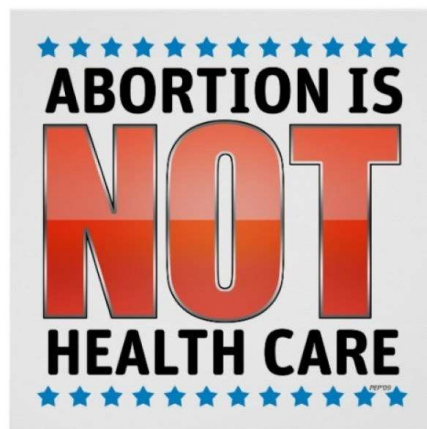
URGENT CALL TO ACTION! PLEASE HELP OUT!
