

# **Urgent Call for Diapers and Formula!!**

**We have seen a huge demand for diapers and formula so far this year in our Stork's Nest Emergency Baby Pantry.**

From January through May of this year, almost 600 clients have visited our baby pantry, with 151 being new clients!

We have provided these clients with over 13,000 diapers, along with 255 cans of formula. More than 50% of our clients receive formula.

In May alone, we provided 3,400 diapers and 75 cans of formula.

**We need your help so we can continue meeting the needs of these children and families!**

Our most common diapers needs are sizes 4, 5, and 6. The types of formula we most often provide are Similac Advance powder formula, Similac Soy powder formula, and Similac Sensitive powder formula.
