

ROE V WADE in 2020

This week marks the **47th ANNIVERSARY** of the tragic **ROE V. WADE** US Supreme Court decision. Since that date, over **65 MILLION CHILDREN** have **BEEN LOST TO ABORTION**. What has been the recent **local impact** of this **decision**?

OHIO

In 2018, Ohio reported 20,425 surgical abortions. That's 56 every day of the year, and almost equivalent to the entire population of Centerville (24,000).

MONTGOMERY COUNTY

In 2018, Montgomery County reported 2871 surgical abortions, almost all done at the late-term Women's Med Center in Kettering. That's 55 babies each week. While Ohio's numbers continued to modestly shrink (2%) from the previous year, Montgomery County's numbers are up dramatically by 22%. **DAYTON** is becoming an **ABORTION DESTINATION!**

WOMEN'S MED CENTER

- License revoked by the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) in November of 2016.
- Appealed the ODH decision and lost at the Montgomery County Common Pleas Court (August 2018), the Ohio Court of Appeals (March 2019), and the Ohio Supreme Court (August and October 2019).
- Remained open the entire three-year period because of a court-ordered stay and aborted well over 7000 infants without a valid license from the state of Ohio!

SO WHY IS WOMEN'S MED CENTER STILL OPEN?

In November 2019, after fighting for over three years to close Women's Med Center, the Ohio Department of Health issued it a new license. The reason: four local doctors below, all members of Wright State Physicians, agreed to provide "back-up physician services" in case of emergency, thus qualifying Women's Med Center for a new license.
